## Part A: the large Center Star

I changed background fabric 22 of the large Center Star Part A: BC33, the white fabric into BCB 31Q-2: the Silver dots  
White = Fabric 24

	Part A	Center Star	<p>Base of the Large center star. Cut 2 strips of 5 3/4" x WOF. Cut from the first strip 9 pieces of 5 3/4" X 4 1/2" and from the second strip 7 pieces of 5 3/4" X 4 1/2" to get a total of 16 pieces of 5 3/4" X 4 1/2".</p>

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## Part B: the first Flying Geese set.

Two whites are used in the first set of the Flying Geese of part B. I changed foundation points 1 and 9 from BC33 into the following whites: BCB 31Q-2: the Silver dots white (fabric 24) and in BCB26Q-X the Ditzzy Daisy white Fabric 22.

 <p><b>BCB 31Q-2:</b> <b>Fabric 24: Silver Dots</b></p>	Part B	<b>Foundation point 9</b>	For the interior Flying Geese which touched the Centre Star of part A, I used the Silver Dots. Cut 3 strips of 2½" x WOF We need a total of 64 pieces of 2½" x 1¾". From the first 2 strips cut 24 pieces each of 2½" x 1¾" = 48 pieces total. From the last strip you cut 16 pieces of 2½" x 1¾" to get a total of 64 pieces of 2½" x 1¾".
 <p><b>BCB 26Q-X</b> <b>Fabric 22: Ditzzy Daisy</b></p>	Part B	<b>Foundation point 1</b>	For the exterior Flying Geese which touched the floating stars of Part C I used the Ditzzy Daisy fabric. Cut 3 strips of 2½" x WOF We need a total of 64 pieces of 2½" x 1¾". From the first 2 strips cut 24 pieces each of 2½" x 1¾" = 48 pieces total. From the last strip you cut 16 pieces of 2½" x 1¾" to get a total of 64 pieces of 2½" x 1¾".

## Part C: The base of the stars

I changed background fabric 22, the base of the 16 stars Part C: from BC33, the white fabric into BCB 26Q-X: the Ditzzy Daisy white = Fabric 22

 <p><b>BCB 26Q-X</b> <b>Fabric 22: Ditzzy Daisy</b></p>	Part C	Base of the Star circle	Base of the stars. We need a total of 128 pieces of 5" x 4". Cut 13 strips of 5" x WOF.  Cut from the first 12 strips 10 pieces of 5" x 4" = 120 pieces total. From the last strip you cut 8 pieces of 5" x 4" to get a total of 128 pieces of 5" x 4".
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## Part D: the second Flying Geese set.

I changed foundation point 9 from background fabric 22, the white fabric BC33, into BCB 26Q-X: the Ditzzy Daisy white. Which is according to the Blush fabric chart also fabric 22.

 <p><b>BCB 26Q-X</b> <b>Fabric 22: Ditzzy Daisy</b></p>	Part D	<b>Foundation point: 9</b>	For the interior Flying Geese which touched the floating stars of part C, I used the Ditszy Daisy fabric. We need a total of 96 pieces of $2\frac{3}{4}'' \times 1\frac{3}{4}''$ .  Cut 4 strips of $2\frac{3}{4}'' \times \text{WOF}$ . Cut each of the 4 strips into 24 pieces of $2\frac{3}{4}'' \times 1\frac{3}{4}'' = 96$ pieces total.
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I also changed foundation point 1 from background fabric 20, the black fabric: BC25, into BCB 25Q-X: the Star Garden Fabric which is according to the Blush fabric chart also fabric 20.

 <p><b>BCB 25Q-X</b> <b>Fabric 20: Blush Star Garden</b></p>	Part D	<b>Foundation point: 1</b>	For the exterior Flying Geese which touched the large corner parts of part E, I used the colorful Blush Star Garden fabric. We need a total of 96 pieces of $2'' \times 3''$  Cut 5 strips of $3'' \times \text{WOF}$ Cut from the first 4 strips $4 \times 21$ pieces of $2'' \times 3'' = 84$ pieces total. From the last strip you cut 12 pieces of $2'' \times 3''$ to get a total of 96 pieces of $2'' \times 3''$ .
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## Part E: The Large Corner parts

I changed the Large Corner parts, part E from black fabric BC 25 into the gorgeous Blush Star garden fabric: BCB 25Q-X, which is fabric 20, according to the Blush fabric chart.

I also changed the outside border and the binding from fabric BC 25 into the Blush Star Garden fabric BCB 25Q-X

	Part E	Large Corner parts E, Border and Binding	For the large Corner parts of part E, the Outside Border and the Binding we use the rest of the Blush Star Garden fabric: 3¾ yards. For the outside border cut we cut 8 strips of 3" x WOF and for the binding we cut 8 strips of 2½" x WOF.

## Part F: the grey and white sashings

I changed the black and white stripe fabric 21, from BC28, into the grey and white stripe: BC28-1.

	Part F	Cut 13 strips of 1" x WOF. We need 5-6 strips for the inside striped sashing of the flying geese border and 7 strips for the outside of the flying geese border.

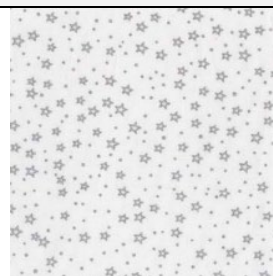




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## Part I: the background fabric of the 4 corner stars

I changed background fabric 22, the base of the 4 corner stars Part I: from BC33, the white fabric into BCB 27Q-2: the white with silver stars = Fabric 23

Cut 3 strips of  $3\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF

We need a total of 32 pieces of  $3\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $3\frac{3}{4}$ ".

Cut 11 pieces of  $3\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $3\frac{3}{4}$ " from the first two strips = 22 pieces total. From the third strip cut 10 pieces of  $3\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $3\frac{3}{4}$ " to get a total of 32 pieces.
